RE: FAMILY ANCESTRY OF WILLIAM ISAAC JONES - YOUR FILE #45-9875-432

I. SUMMATION:

inally, we have another report to you regarding your request of January 26th. I hope that you have time to consume most of it before you leave on vacation as I trust that you will find it most interesting. It certainly has extended your known lineages extensively and few researchers get back to the 1500s as we have for you. The reason being is that few records in the UK are as comprehensive for as long a period as Cornwall and Devon counties. Here is a summary of what we have learned to-date-

For this report we concentrated, primarily, on the ancestral connections only and have been able to extend further back most of the lines of your maternal grandfather, **William Isaac Jones**, other than the Hambley line. This one will take much more investigation because I am not convinced that they originated in Cornwall as we have been having difficulty in tracing this lineage in this county. Regarding the Jones direct line, we have extended that two (2) more generations to 1750 of **William & Elizabeth Jones** of Cornwall County.

Your assessment was correct in that **George Jones** (b. 1824) was the son of **Robert Jones & Ann**Netherton as you will see. In addition, on George Jones maternal line we have extended the Netherton's three (3) more generations back to 1710 with **Richard & Ann Netherton** of Cornwall County. The Fuge line we have extended three (3) generations to c. 1735, as well, to **Robert & Mary Fuge** and **John & Grace Buller** of Cornwall County. On Isaac Fuge's maternal side, the Babb line was extended nine (9) further generations to c.1585 which comprises primarily surnames of Babb & Saundry of Cornwall County.

As you can tell, the search has gone very well and much is left to be done but take a few months to mull it over and enjoy the British vacation. Then you can decide where you wish for us to investigate further.

Herein are the detail search strategies for this report. Please also refer to the enclosed *Pedigree Chart, Family Group Charts and Relationship Charts* for additional information on family inter-relationships:

II. **OBJECTIVE:** To "determine as much as possible about the ancestors of Richard H. Jones and Elizabeth Fuge-Jones lines".

III. PROBLEMS: There really were no mention-able problems with the search as the subjects, periods and locations were well defined from earlier investigations. The Thomas & Mary Hambley lines will require further time & investigations not committed to with this reporting period due to major difficulties in locating ancestral connections.

IX. SUGGESTIONS FOR FUTURE SEARCH: Regarding your paternal side, we believe that we have pretty much extended your Fuge, Buller, Babb and Netherton lines as far as possible, ancestrally. That may change as one uncovers more information on the offspring structures resulting from these early ancestors however at the moment we feel that the records are just not there to support further extensions ancestrally.

One should now concentrate on extending the descendancy base for these lines. Ancestrally & descendancy, more can be done on the Jones, **Hambley**, and **Barnes** lines. We have not addressed future research regarding your maternal line at this time.

There are several avenues we would take this search with a next report to complete the lines further, if you wish to continue this search. In brief they are as follows:

- 1). Continue descendancy research on the George & Catherine Jones lines.
- 2). Continue descendancy research on the Isaac & Martha Fuge lines.
- 3). Continue ancestral research on the Thomas & Mary Hambley line
- 4). Continue ancestral research on the George & Elizabeth Barnes line.
